Genesis 1 v 1 - 5




Find the highlighted words in the grid!



In the **beginning God created** the **sky** and the **earth**. The earth was **empty** and had no **form**. **Darkness covered** the **ocean**, and God's **Spirit** was **moving** over the **water**.




Creation : Day Two


Genesis 1 v 6 - 8




Creation : Day Three



Genesis 1:10-And God called the **dry land** Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that it was good.






Dirt Worm Maze


